Chenin Blanc

- Indaba Chenin Blanc 2009 Western Cape** 7 28
Jam packed with tropical fruit, citrus, and melon this ridiculously crisp and clean white is the perfect pairing for all seafoods and salads. Why get a glass when you can get a bottle?
- Kanu Chenin Blanc 2008 Stellenbosch** 9 36
This super refreshing Chenin has a splash of Sauvignon Blanc and Viognier in it which makes it delicious year round. A "best value" from Wine Spectator Magazine the Kanu Chenin is packed with delicate floral and spice notes.
- Ken Forrester Petit Chenin Black 2008** 10 39
Crafted by one of South Africa's greatest wine makers this Chenin Blanc is medium bodied with hints of orange peel, tart granny smith apple, and lovely grapefruit. Stony minerality makes this great with seafood and anything spicy!

Sauvignon Blanc

- Brampton Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Western Cape** 8 34
Produced on the world famous Rustenberg Estate this zesty Sauvignon Blanc has a perfect balance of citrus and acidity. A Wine Enthusiast "Best Buy" that is perfect with salads and veggies or by itself.
- Durbanville Hills Sauvignon Blanc 2009** 8 28
Seamlessly layered flavors ranging from tropical fruit to fig, lime, guava and gooseberry, leading up to a crisp finish.
- Beyond Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Coastal Region** 10 38
Loaded with flavors of herb and lime and backed by cool acidity, the Beyond Sauvignon Blanc is produced from grapes grown a stone's throw from the rocky shores of the Atlantic Ocean.

Chardonnay

- Indaba Chardonnay 2009 Western Cape** 8 28
What an incredible Chardonnay for the price! You have to try this with the prawns. Bright yellow in color with hints of honey, citrus, and vanilla it may be your new favorite wine!
- De Morgenzon Estate Chardonnay 2008 Western Cape** 11 45
This wine comes from the famed De Morgenzon Estate. This high elevation estate has 360 degree views of Stellenbosch and the surrounding water (False Bay and the Indian Ocean). This chard is full bodied and great during the cool winter months or on a hot summer day with something spicy.

Riesling

- Nederburg Special Late Harvest 2008 Paarl** 9 36
This is a luscious blend of fully-ripened Chenin Blanc, Gewürztraminer and Weisser Riesling; Nederburg Special Late Harvest 2008 is a finessed balance between mouth-filling sweetness, tempered by lively acidity, and pure fruit.
- Buitenverwachting Riesling 2008 Constantia** 10 38
Buitenverwachting – meaning Beyond Expectations – produces this elegant dry Riesling. This wine combines a floral nose, with lime, mineral, and apple on the palate. The long finish here is excellent with fish and spicy meat dishes.

Blush

- Mulderbosch Rose 2009 (Western Cape)** 10 40
Made with 100% Cabernet Sauvignon this rose erupts with fresh strawberry on the nose and a lively, crisp, and alluring palate. This is a universal pairing wine – drink with anything on the Madiba menu and enjoy.

Sparkling

- Pearly Bay Moscato NV Paarl** 8 32
Light-hearted, easy drinking, and perfect for celebrating life's everyday occasions!
- Graham Beck Brut NV Robertson** 12 50
This bubbly is pale gold, with a frothy mousse; it's fresh and fruity, clean and delicate with scents of melon. Take a toast with the sparkling wine that Obama drank on election night.

Dessert

- Heaven on Earth Muscat d'Alexandrie 2008 Trawal Northwestern Cape** 10 45
The scents and flavors of apricot, honey, and rooibos offer a taste of heaven right here at Madiba. A fair trade and organic wine.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- Excelsior Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 Robertson** 8 34
Robertson, where this wine comes from, is hot during the day and cool at night – ideal conditions for ripening Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine has hints of cherry, chocolate, and spice. This pairs well with Madiba's rib-eye steaks.
- Stellar Organics Cabernet 2007 Trawal Northwestern Cape** 11 42
This fair-trade wine exhibits characteristics Cabernet Sauvignon traits – ripe tannins and no harsh edges make this a delightful wine with oxtail or steak.
- Brampton Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 Western Cape** 57
A blend of Cabernet, Merlot, Shiraz and Movedre, this delicious cabernet bursts onto the palate with bright, juicy flavors of blackberry, cassis, licorice, and cherry intertwined with subtle vanilla, tobacco, and spice.

Shiraz and Syrah

- Indaba Shiraz 2009 Western Cape** 8 30
Lots of ripe black cherry fruit with spice and pepper notes and an easy-going finish. Try this with burgers and boerewors.
- Jam Jar Sweet Shiraz 2009 Western Cape** 9 36
Luscious fruity goodness in every sip! This light, fresh, and fruity Shiraz is semi-sweet. Taste blackberries, raspberries and hints of dark chocolate Jam Jar is great with meat, cheese, and dessert! Great for people who claim to only like white wine.
- Durbanville Hills Shiraz 2009** 9 33
A soft –textured but mouth filling wine with spicy and smoky oak flavors that lingers on the after taste.
- Lievland Shiraz 2004 Stellenbosch** 12 50
This is a true expression of terroir. An elegant wine showing ripe cherries and pomegranates with a subtle spiciness on the finish. One of the first South African wines in the United States!
- Lievland Field Blend 2004 (Stellenbosch)** 36
The Lievland Field Blend is made from the Estate's best varietals. Ripe berries, a hint of cherry and elegant spices make this smooth wine a pleasure to drink. You'll find Shiraz, Cinsault, Roobernet, and Ruby Cabernet mingling in this bottle.

Pinotage

- Man Vintners Pinotage 2007 Western Cape** 8 32
Pinotage is South Africa's indigenous grape varietal. A hybrid cross of Pinot Noir and Cinsault expect earthy, smoky, and soft red wine.
- Fairview Pinotage 2008 Paarl** 42
A rich, black cherry flavor. This wine is 100% Pinotage and 100% South African! Serve with ostrich, hearty vegetarian dishes, barbeques, beef, and lamb.

Merlot

- Indaba Merlot 2008 Western Cape** 8 30
This Merlot will remind you how great Merlot really is. Have a glass of this lip-smacking merlot with biltong and droewors and expect to taste cherries, plums, dark berries, and a hint of dark chocolate.
- Fleur du Cap Merlot 2008 Stellenbosch** 9 36
Berry flavors and a whiff of soft oak round out this elegant merlot. This wine has velvety tannins that provide an excellent balance to a wine which finishes with lingering fruit.

Blends

- Boekenhoutskloof Wolftrap 2008 Western Cape** 52
A very friendly blend of Syrah, Movedre, and Viognier, the Wolftrap has great concentration showing fruity and floral notes. A must try for any South African wine aficionado.
- Rustenberg John X. Merriman 2006 Stellenbosch** 84
This sensational Bordeaux blend is named for the Prime Minister of the Cape who purchased and revitalized part of the historical Rustenberg Estate in the late 1800's. One of South Africa's most iconic bottling, it delivers intense, smoky flavors of tobacco, cherry, licorice, and plum, intertwined with complex notes of mineral and spice.
